RESUMPTION OF FACE-TO-FACE LEARNING

I refer to the Media Broadcast released by the Ministry of Education (MoE) dated 1st July 2020.

With the Level 3 de-escalation plan put in place, the abovementioned students will have face-to-face learning in school. This will start with effect from **Saturday, 4th July 2020**. However, with the emphasis on *social distancing* and our limited classrooms, the classes will be rotated accordingly. In addition, to cover the lost face-to-face learning time, students are also required to attend classes on Friday. Therefore, please take note of the school days for students at the various levels shown below:

- 1. Year 7 – Every Thursday and Friday (2 days) in school.**
Thursday: 7.15 am – 12.00 pm & Friday: 7.30 am – 11.00 am.
The rest of the days will be Home Based Learning/Online Learning.
- 2. Year 9 – Every Monday, Wednesday, and Friday (3 days) in school.**
Monday and Wednesday: 7.15 am – 12.00 pm & Friday: 7.30 am – 11.00 am.
The rest of the days will be Home Based Learning/Online Learning.
- 3. Year 10 – Every Tuesday, Friday, and Saturday (3 days) in school.**
Tuesday and Saturday: 7.15 am – 12.00 pm & Friday: 7.30 am – 11.00 am.
The rest of the days will be Home Based Learning/Online Learning.

Note: Examination classes Year 8 and Year 11 students are required come to school every school day

At the same time, we would like to inform parents & guardians to take note and adhere to the following instructions:

- Prepare food for your child/children to bring to school.
- Provide the necessary essential items, e.g. tissue/face towel, drinking water, hand sanitizers, etc. for your child to bring to school.
- Remind/Teach your child/children to **NOT** share food/personal items with others, **NOT** to touch their face and **ALWAYS** wash their hands with hand soap.
- **DO NOT** send your child/children to school **IF** the child/children is/are unwell or vulnerable.
- **DO NOT** come to school **IF** the parents/guardians are unwell **UNLESS** you have an appointment with the school.

- Gathering in the school compound/school premises is **NOT** allowed, especially when waiting for your child/children to finish school.
- Provide your child/children with small notes to minimize the changes of notes/coins (as canteen will still be opened for booking of food only).
- Only **ONE ADULT** is allowed to enter the school premises/compound (to drop off and pick up your child/children) to avoid overcrowding (Social Distancing).
- Payment of school fees online are encouraged. Parents/Guardians are to take a snapshot of the receipt/s, write down the name and class of the child/children and email to the school's Assistant Accounts Clerk (leny.low@stgeorges.edu.bn) or send a WhatsApp to your child's/children's respective Class Teachers. This is important for the school to keep track of the student's payment.

We thank you so much for your patience and understanding as we all adjust to the drastic changes in life these past few weeks.

Let us all pray for the continuous improvement of the pandemic situation in our country so that all the schools will be fully operational soon.
