RESUMPTION OF FACE-TO-FACE LEARNING

With reference to the Media Statement by Ministry of Education dated 28th March 2022, the resumption of face-to-face learning is on again effective **Monday**, 4th (or) **Tuesday**, 5th **April 2022**. **All** students **must** attend school and attendance is **compulsory**.

However, with the emphasis on social distancing and our limited classrooms, the classes will be rotated accordingly. Therefore, please take note of the school days for students at the various levels shown below:

- Year 7 Every Wednesday and Saturday (2 day) in school.
 The rest of the days will be Home Based Learning/Online Learning.
- 2. Year 8 Every Monday and Thursday (2 days) in school.
 The rest of the days will be Home Based Learning/Online Learning.
- 3. Year 9 Every Tuesday and Saturday (2 days) in school.

 The rest of the days will be Home Based Learning/Online Learning.
- 4. Year 10 Every Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday (4 days) in school. On Saturday will be Home Based Learning/Online Learning.
- 5. Year 11 Every Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday & Saturday (5 days) in school.

Also take note that during the month of Ramadhan, our school hours are 7.45 am - 11.50 am. Kindly arrange to send your child/ward to school and then pick them from school at the time stated.

The following are the precautionary measures against Covid-19 pandemic (directive from MoE):

 School will perform check on body temperature to teachers, students, and parents/guardians.

- Students are required to perform Antigen Rapid Test (ART) at home twice a week before they come to school.
- Students should inform their respective class teachers about their ART results, and if any of the student's results is positive, the said student should not attend school.
- Wearing masks at all times in school is compulsory for all students. Double masks or face shields are encouraged.
- Parents/Guardians should supply face masks and hand sanitizers to their children.
- Students are **encouraged** to take breakfast at home, pack food from home and not to share food with others.
- DO NOT send your child/children to school if they are unwell.
- Parents/Guardians are required to scan on the BruHealth QR code, body temperature, and should be fully vaccinated before they enter the school compound. Parents who are not fully vaccinated are required to show their Antigen Rapid Test (ART) results.
- Parents/Guardians are NOT allowed to enter the school IF they are unwell.

Your cooperation is highly needed in helping our school to operate in compliance with MoE and Ministry of Health (MoH) requirements.

We thank you so much for your patience and understanding as we all adjust to the drastic changes in life these past few weeks.

Let us all pray for the continuous improvement of the pandemic situation in our country so that all the schools will be fully operational soon.
