FACE-TO-FACE LEARNING FOR YEAR 11 STUDENTS

Year 11 students will sit for their GCE 'O' Level Examination in October/November 2022, and a few of them will also sit for the said examination in May/June 2022. These examinations are important and will determine the students' next academic progress level, and their future paths in life. Last year's Year 11 students had several months doing online learning, and teachers were having difficulties in finishing the syllabus before they sat for their GCE 'O' Level Examination October/November 2021.

During the Media Conference on 17th March 2022, the Minister of Education has announced that online learning was extended for another two week (from 21st March to 2nd April 2022). However, 'special consideration' will be given to educational institutions who apply for face-to-face learning to prepare students for their international examinations'.

In line with the abovementioned announcement, the school has obtained permission from the Ministry of Education through the Private Education Department to conduct face-to-face lessons to Year 11 students only from 21st March to 2nd April 2022.

Therefore, students are **encouraged** to attend face-to-face learning at school. It will take place from **Tuesday**, **2**nd **March** to **Saturday**, **2**nd **April 2022**.

The school will implement strict SOPs for students and parents by ensuring that:

- Students are required to do Antigen Rapid Test (ART) at home twice a week;
- Students should inform their respective class teachers about their ART results, and if any
 of the student's results is positive, the said student should not attend school;
- Students, teachers, school staff and visitors must take body temperature using a body temperature scanner;
- Students, teachers, school staff and visitors must always adhere to Social Distancing while on the school premises;
- Parents/Guardians should not send their child/ward to school if he/she is unwell;
- Students, teachers, school staff and visitors are required to always wear face masks while at school premises; and



 Parents/Guardians are required to supply face masks and hand sanitizer to their child/ward.

It is our hope to have parents'/guardians' support in our effort to ensure that all students can attend face-to-face/physical classes for better students' engagement and academic benefits.
